

Donations: The Communities of West Weber and Taylor have relied on community members to donate for the development of physical facilities. This includes the costs to build the recreational hall at the local churches, or buy equipment and supplies for teams to participate in at the local High School or surrounding community recreational programs. We need your help to build our own community program.

During the proposed Western Weber Incorporation exercise we went through in 2020, we established a way to donate to the Community. Since the Taylor West Weber Park District is in the community, We can use the 501(c)(3) established for the Western Weber Community Inc. to collect donations for the benefit of the Park District. Donors can deduct contributions they make to us under IRC Code 170. We are also qualified to receive tax deductible bequests, devises, transfers or gifts under Section 2055, 2106 or 2522.

The immediate need is for land and water. LAND FOR PARKS IS A PREMIUM. Our wish was that 100 years ago our community leaders should have set aside land, however the traditional churches in the area meet the need for their members. For future generations we need

to plan and build meet that need. If you want your land to remain in PERPETUAL OPEN SPACE, and not become the next subdivision, check with your tax advisor and see the strategies we can work out to provide for the social, emotional and physical needs of community members.
